Removing lid (for non confidential options ignore steps 1 & 9)



Turn key anti clockwise to unlock lid.



Lift lid from the front end, tilting backwards to free from rear locator.



With two hands lift the lid clear of the body & put to one side.



Inserting sack



Locate sack around the rear of the body, slide the edges of the sack into the gap in the moulding.



Pull the sack taught and locate around the upstand at the front of the body.



Sack is taught and secured in bin body.

Replacing lid




Locate the rear peg of the lid under the lip at the back of the body.



Allow the lid to drop into position ensuring the front peg locates in the body.



Push the lock in firmly fixing the lid in place.
